Classroom Supplies for Homeroom Teachers *Will be distributed evenly and utilized for all middle school classes.

- 1 pair scissors
- 1 box markers
- 1 box colored pencils
- Highlighters (green, pink, yellow, blue variety packs if possible)
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 package of glue sticks - Elmer's
- Sticky notes any color, size 3 inch or larger

Personal Items *Names should be written on them and items will be kept with students daily in personal storage system/lockers.
